



## Examples of Learning Outcomes

### **Knowledge-Based Outcomes**

1. Understanding of European Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Systems:
  - Gain comprehensive knowledge of the structure, organization, and protocols of EMS in the host country.
  - Compare and contrast the EMS systems between the home and host countries.
2. Medical Procedures and Protocols:
  - Learn and understand advanced medical procedures and protocols used in the host country, including pre-hospital care, patient stabilisation, and transportation.

### **Skills-Based Outcomes**

3. Communication and Language Skills:
  - Improve medical terminology in the host country's language to facilitate better patient interaction and collaboration with local healthcare professionals.
  - Develop intercultural communication skills, essential for working in diverse environments.
4. Teamwork and Collaboration:
  - Enhance ability to work effectively within international and multicultural teams.
  - Participate in joint training exercises and simulations to foster collaborative problem-solving and decision-making skills.

### **Attitudinal Outcomes**

6. Professional Development and Ethics:
  - Foster a deeper understanding of professional ethics and patient confidentiality within different cultural contexts.
  - Develop a global perspective on healthcare challenges and solutions, promoting a more holistic approach to patient care.
7. Adaptability and Flexibility:
  - Cultivate the ability to adapt to different clinical environments and unexpected situations.
  - Demonstrate resilience and flexibility in managing diverse medical emergencies.

### **Reflective Outcomes**

8. Critical Thinking and Reflective Practice:
  - Engage in reflective practice to critically analyse personal experiences and learning during the mobility period.
  - Identify areas for personal and professional growth and develop action plans for continued improvement.
9. Cultural Awareness and Sensitivity:
  - Increase cultural awareness and sensitivity, recognizing the impact of cultural differences on patient care and professional practice.
  - Reflect on and respect the values, beliefs, and practices of the host country and how they influence healthcare delivery.
