



Examples of Tasks

Knowledge-Based Outcomes

1. **Understanding of European Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Systems:**
 - **Ride-Alongs:** Participate in ambulance ride-alongs to observe the EMS system in action.
 - **Protocols Briefing:** Receive briefings on local EMS protocols and procedures from experienced paramedics.
2. **Medical Procedures and Protocols:**
 - **Observe:** Observe medical procedures performed by the paramedic team.
 - **Patient Assessment:** Learn to perform patient assessments following the host country's protocols.

Skills-Based Outcomes

3. **Practical Emergency Medical Skills:**
 - **Vital Signs Monitoring:** Practice measuring and recording patients' vital signs, such as blood pressure, heart rate, and respiratory rate.
 - **Wound Care:** Assist in providing wound care and management, including dressing and bandaging.
4. **Communication and Language Skills:**
 - **Patient Interaction:** Communicate with patients and their families, using basic phrases and medical terminology in English or the local language.
 - **Radio Communication:** Learn to use ambulance radio systems to communicate with dispatch and hospital staff.
5. **Teamwork and Collaboration:**
 - **Team Coordination:** Participate in coordinating patient care with the paramedic team during emergencies.
 - **Post-Call Debriefings:** Engage in debriefing sessions after calls to discuss what went well and what could be improved.

Attitudinal Outcomes

6. **Professional Development and Ethics:**
 - **Patient Confidentiality:** Practice maintaining patient confidentiality and professional ethics in real-world situations.
 - **Ethical Decision-Making:** Observe and discuss ethical decision-making processes with experienced paramedics.

Reflective Outcomes

8. **Critical Thinking and Reflective Practice:**
 - **Case Reflection:** Reflect on specific cases handled during shifts, noting challenges and learning points.
 - **Mentor Feedback:** Receive and reflect on feedback from paramedic mentors regarding performance and areas for improvement.

9. Cultural Awareness and Sensitivity:

- **Cultural Sensitivity:** Observe and practice culturally sensitive patient care, respecting local customs and practices.
- **Community Interaction:** Engage with patients from diverse backgrounds to better understand cultural influences on healthcare.
